

PIMAlink 2.0

QUICK GUIDE



PIMAlink 2.0 by Pima Electronic Systems is a smartphone application that allows home owners and users of PIMA's intruder alarm systems, to receive alarm notifications and visual verification images, and to remotely arm and disarm the alarm system from anywhere.

The **PIMAlink 2.0** application is available for Android



and iOS

THE MENU

Button	Tap this button to...
System	view the alarm system's current state, arm and disarm.
Zones	view the zones status: open, alarmed and bypassed.
Notifications	view the notifications' log
Outputs (Android) *	activate/deactivate outputs (external devices)
Faults (iOS)*	view the fault list

INSTALLATION AND CONFIGURATION

Before you begin

1. Make sure you have in hand the alarm system's Master code. The Master code is the only code that can be used to view and manage the list of the other users of the application.
2. Make sure to download and install the **PIMAlink 2.0** application from the Apple store/google play, on any device that needs to pair with the cloud. To connect other devices in the future, repeat the detailed below pairing process.
3. The users of the application can use the Master code or any User code (of the alarm system) to connect to the alarm system. The user permissions are the same permissions as in the alarm system.
4. Up to 32/4 smartphones (in Force /Hunter-Pro and Captain 8, respectively) can be used per every alarm system.
5. Each device can be paired with up to 16 alarm systems.

How to pair the alarm system

To start using the application on your smartphone, you need to create a secure connection (pair) between the **PIMAlink 2.0** cloud and the alarm system, and pair your smartphone. To do that, follow the next instructions.

1. **FORCE**: on a keypad, enter the Master code and press: **System Options -> Communication Options -> PIMA Cloud -> Pair to PIMAlink**, and wait for the cloud to generate a unique pairing code. Your alarm system is now paired with the **PIMAlink 2.0** cloud.
HUNTER-PRO and CAPTAIN 8: on a keypad, enter the Master code and select **ENTR -> NEXT (PIMA Cloud) -> ENTR -> NEXT X2 (Pairing) -> ENTR**, and wait for the cloud to generate a unique pairing code. Your alarm system is now paired with the **PIMAlink 2.0** cloud.
2. Use this same code to pair the smartphones; see next. For security reasons the code is valid only for 10 minutes. To connect other smartphones in the future, repeat the process.
3. Exit the menu (press End).

How to pair a smartphone

1. Run the **PIMAlink 2.0** application.
2. Tap **Settings**.
3. Enter your name, phone number and email address, and press Done.
4. Tap the **+** button.
5. Type a **Name** for the alarm system (or leave the default "Alarm System").
6. If the alarm system is located on another time zone, select its **Time Zone**.
7. Enter the **Pairing code**.

* Both options appear on different places on the two platforms.

8. Tap **Done**. A confirmation message should appear.
9. Exit the menu on the control panel (press End). Your phone is now paired with the **PIMAlink 2.0** cloud.



Only one smartphone can be connected to the control panel at the same time.

MORE OPTIONS BUTTON

The three ellipsis button offers some different options per each button (System, Zones, etc.). The next table lists the options.

Button	More options
System	Faults, Log, Disconnect
Zones	Zone Bypass
Reports	Filter (events)
Outputs	Stop Siren (button)

EDIT MENU

The Edit menu is available before you connect to the alarm system and used for the following:

- Unpair from the alarm system: tap the no entry symbol.
 - Edit and set parameters: tap the alarm system's name. The edit options are listed below.
1. **Outputs:** the outputs can be used for activating various devices*, such as gates. Each output is activated by a separate Control Code. The codes are set to be active/inactive in this screen.
 2. **Notifications:** select which events you want to be notified on (set separately in each device).
 3. **Contacts:** a list of all the paired devices. This menu is visible only when using the Master code. The contacts details are taken from the users Setting screen. You can unpair a contact by tapping the no entry symbol next to it (Android) or pressing Edit/Delete (iOS).
 4. **Allow Tech Access:** matches the same action in the **FORCE** alarm system.
 5. **Update Parameters:** tap to update changes.

SETTINGS

The user's details in the Settings screen are used to identify the users by the master user. Only the master user can view and manage the list of all the users of the application.

* Setting outputs to activate devices is done by a qualified technician.
